Junior – under-16 and items must be their property (purchased, display designed and built by them). Novice – Having never won in any category at any show.

### **ABCR Favorite Five**

ABCR Auctions will choose its winner using the following:

1. Eye appeal of display. 2. Information. 3. Variety 4. Rarity. 5. Condition.

ABCR Auctions' aim is to get heaps of displays that look great to the public, give the public great information and show bottles that are in good nick. Theoretically, a display with five common bottles could win if a huge effort goes in to the other four areas. The prize awarded may well differ from the first prize awarded by the show judges, but this will be due to differing judging criteria.
